SHARON ART STUDIO PROGRAM

The Sharon Art Studio serves 2,500 adults and seniors and 1,000 children and youth annually. We offer weekly classes and special workshops in ceramics, glass, jewelry, drawing, and painting. We offer a wide variety of youth classes including Free Teen classes (ages 15-17) and a summer art enrichment program called "Art-in-the-Park" (ages 11-15). The program operates under the auspices of the San Francisco and Recreation and Park Department and the Friends of the Sharon Art Studio.

HISTORY of FOSAS

FOSAS was founded in 1991 to preserve the Sharon Art program which was threatened by budget cuts to the Recreation and Park Department. The 1991 budget cuts resulted in the reduction of the teaching staff by one third. In 1992, the Supervisor of the Arts and Crafts division, who oversaw the program, retired and the Recreation and Park Department eliminated the position. To compensate for these dramatic losses, FOSAS hired a director and broadened the program. Over the years, FOSAS has played an increasingly crucial role in expanding the class offerings and currently sponsors approximately 40% of the entire program.
