Materials List

- Oil Pastels

The instructor will be using **(brand) Sennelier (set) 24 assorted colors.**

This set is highly recommended as the *Sennelier oil pastels* are very rich and creamy, and the 24 colors offers a variety of color mixing possibilities.

- Paper

140 lb. watercolor paper. Expensive paper is not necessary for this medium.

- Tools

Synthetic, inexpensive #12 round watercolor brush. We will be using *Gamsol*, a non-toxic, low odor alternative to turpentine to paint the oil pastels. Your brush should not be used to paint with after this use.

- Tools

Colour Shaper, flat chisel, #6. These tools look like a brush, having a long wood handle and ferrule, but instead of bristles have a wedge shaped, hard rubber head.

- #B Pencil and Eraser

- Paper Towels and Rags
