TOMBOW PENS

- You can bring single colors that you choose or sets of specific colors. Make sure that you have a variety of at least 10 pens. Also, there are many brands of “water-soluble brush & pen”. If you have another brand you can bring that, but make sure they are water-soluble, (not permanent) and have both a brush tip and pen tip.

PAPER

- Watercolor Paper Pad, 9” x 12”. Mixed-Media pads are not recommended since they cannot take much water.

The instructor will be using a Canson Montval, Artist Series Watercolor Book

#10 or #12 ROUND WATERCOLOR BRUSH AND ½” FLAT WATERCOLOR BRUSH

- It is not recommended that you bring a waterbrush (plastic brush with water in the handle) as these will not give you complete control over how much water you use or your brush strokes.

WATER CONTAINER

KITCHEN SPONGE

- You will use this to wipe your brush on. It’s more effective than rags. Bring a new sponge or one you have used for this purpose before.

#B or #2B PENCIL and ERASER
