

## Water Soluble Wax Crayons

- Water-Soluble Wax Crayons

Make sure to get “crayons” not pastels or gel sticks. They need to be “water-soluble” or “aquastics”/“aquacolor”. The companies Caran d’Ache and Faber-Castell make good water-soluble wax crayons. The instructor will be using *Caran d’Ache, Neocolor II* series.

- Watercolor Brushes

Round, Size #10 or #12, & Flat, size  $\frac{3}{4}$ ” or 1” (Or whatever you have that is close to these.) Do not bring expensive watercolor brushes. Synthetic, inexpensive brands are fine.

- Paper

Watercolor Pad, cold-press, 9” x 12”

- Pencil and Eraser

#B or #2B Graphite Pencil and eraser

- Water Container

- Rags or Sponge for Wet Brush
