Main Materials

- ***Paints:** Bring whatever watercolor paints you have.
Minimum: yellow, red, blue, green, violet, orange and neutral tint or indigo blue
- ***Watercolor Paper:** 9" x 12", cold press, 140lb watercolor paper pad
- ***Brushes:** Bring whatever you have but be sure to have a round, recommended size #12 or #14, or bigger and a flat, recommended size ¾"

- Drawing Pad: 5" x 7" or 8" x 10" inexpensive drawing paper for composition and value thumbnails.
- #B Graphite Pencil and Kneaded Eraser
- Water Container
- Rags and Paper Towels

***Recommended Brands**

- Watercolor Paints: Daniel Smith, Winsor and Newton Professional (NOT Cotman), Holbein
- Watercolor Brushes: Princeton Heritage series, Princeton Velvet Touch series
- Paper: Good paper is the most important of all your materials. Arches, Waterford, and Fabriano Artístico are all good brands. (Do not buy the less expensive pads, you will regret it.)
